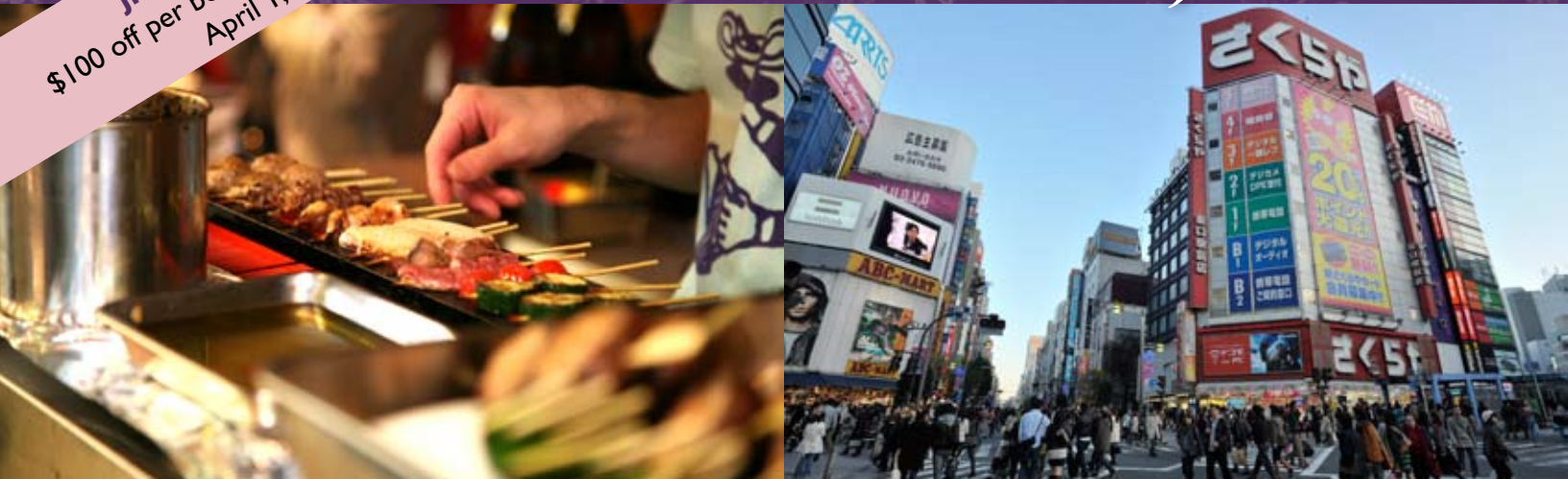

## ITINERARY – 8 DAYS

### Day 1: Arrive Tokyo

Arrive at New Tokyo International Airport (Narita Airport). Upon arrival, you will be met by a SITA representative at the exit and assisted on board an airport limousine bus to your hotel.

### Day 2: Tokyo Sightseeing

Enjoy a seat-in-coach (SIC) tour of Tokyo. The tour will visit Tokyo Tower Observatory, Imperial Palace Plaza, Asakusa Kannon Temple, Nakamise shopping arcade and Tasaki Pearl Gallery. The afternoon is at leisure. (B)

### Day 3: Tokyo / Mt. Fuji & Hakone Tour

Travel this morning by deluxe coach to Mt. Fuji. Drive half-way up Japan's highest mountain to enjoy a spectacular view

from a height of 7,500 feet. After lunch at the Hotel Highland Resort, transfer to Hakone. Enjoy a Lake Ashi Boat Cruise and Mt. Komagatake Aerial Cableway (may be omitted due to traffic conditions). HAKONE HOTEL KOWAKIEN (BL)

### Day 4: Hakone / Inuyama

Transfer to Odawara station and board a Shinkansen for Nagoya. Change to Meitetsu train at Nagoya and arrive at Inuyama around at 12:50 p.m. After lunch, visit Inuyama Castle and enjoy a Japan Rhine Boat Cruise. Following dinner at your hotel, enjoy a cormorant fishing show (Ukai) exhibiting the traditional Japanese fishing method. Meitetsu Inuyama Hotel (BLD)

### Day 5: Inuyama / Nagoya / Kyoto

This morning, proceed to Nagoya. Your sightseeing tour includes a visit to Noritake Garden, Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology, Nagoya Castle and Tokugawa Museum of Art. Transfer to Nagoya station to board your train for Kyoto. Upon arrival in Kyoto, you are transferred to your hotel. (BL)

### Day 6: Kyoto Sightseeing / Nara Excursion

This morning, enjoy a tour of Kyoto. Visit Golden Pavilion, Nijo Castle\* and Kyoto Imperial Palace. Following lunch at Kyoto Handicraft Center, proceed to Nara. Visit Todaiji Temple, which houses the Great Buddha; colorful Kasuga Shrine with 3,000 lanterns; and Deer Park. (BL)

*\* If Nijo Castle is closed, the tour will visit Ryoanji Temple. If Kyoto Imperial Palace is closed, the tour will visit Higashi Honganji Temple or Kitano Temmangu Shrine instead.*

### Day 7: Kyoto / Tokyo

This morning is at leisure. Evening board your train for Tokyo. Upon arrival, check into your hotel. (B)

### Day 8: Tokyo / Home

This morning you will be transferred to the airport for your flight back home. (B)
